# NANZQ QUILTS AOTEAROA 2007

## Conditions of Entry

### Categories

**Traditional:** a pattern or design with an established history in the quilting tradition.

**Innovative:** a design with fundamental deviation from traditional patterns and sets, reflecting growth through tradition.

**Fibre Connection;** no restriction on materials or layers used. Must have some recognizable connection to quilting and conform to the standard hanging requirements. To be no more than 1.5m square.

### General;

- Entry is open to financial members of NANZQ from 1 May 2007. Junior entrants are exempt.
- Entries must have been completed in the last three years and must not have been entered in NANZQ Quilts Aotearoa before.
- Entries must be predominantly fabric and made up of three layers: a top, batting and backing. (Except Fibre Connection category)
- Entries must be hand or machine quilted by the entrant(s).
- All parties who work on a quilt must be NANZQ members and must be named on and sign the entry form.
- Commercially quilted works (i.e. you paid someone else to quilt your work) are not acceptable.
- Inspiration or design source must be acknowledged on the entry form (where applicable).
- ALL labels i.e; on quilt, photo, and quilt bag, **must** contain the following information: Name of quilt, size of quilt (width by length in **cm**), name, address and phone number of quiltmaker.

### Size;

- There is no minimum size.
- The maximum size is 2.6 metres in height or width, except Small Innovative Wall Quilts where maximum size is 75cm square and Fibre Connection where maximum size is 1.5m square.
- Embellishments must not extend beyond the size limit.

### Selection;

- All entries will be subjected to a direct selection process i.e. not from photographs.
- Advice of selected entries will be emailed or posted on 12 September. If possible PLEASE provide an email address for communication purposes.

### Entries - Stage 1. – Entry form & photo

- All entries must be on the official entry form and received at **PO Box 12570, Chartwell Square, Hamilton by 24 August 2006.**
- The entrant shall choose which category the work is to be judged in.

Each entry **must** include;

- One entry form per quilt
- One coloured photograph of the whole quilt mounted and labelled as per photo template provided.

### Entries - Stage 2. – Quilts

- Quilt(s) plus a prepaid self-addressed courier bag, for return of quilt(s), are to be received at ; **Donna's Quilt Studio, 8B Rainside Place, Hamilton, between 4 & 7 September 2007.**
- A strip of **hook**-sided Velcro must be firmly stitched to the back top edge of the quilt from binding to binding.
- For packing purposes, please attach **labelled** soft-sided Velcro to this also.
- Quilts of irregular shape/size must have adequate means of hanging, **including** hook-sided Velcro.
- All accepted work must be labelled. Label must be attached to the bottom back **LEFT** corner (when viewed from the back). See additional labelling requirements in General above.
- Quilts are to be presented in a labelled, closable cloth bag.

### Exhibits

- Selected entries will be subjected to a final selection before hanging.
- Any entry received that does not comply with the conditions of entry will be disqualified.
- A 10% commission will be added to the sale price of all quilts for sale.
- Insurance is the responsibility of the exhibitor at all times. The organisers will not accept responsibility for lost, misdirected or delayed mail or any damage to or loss of entries while in their care.
- All selected quilts may be photographed for publicity purposes and by the general public.
- Quilts will be return posted by 1 October.
- The Selectors' and Judges' decisions shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The committee reserves the right not to award a prize in any category if it sees fit.
- Prize winning quilts may be required to travel to the Australasian Quilt Convention in February 2007.
